**Art. 1 - Descrizione**

1. Gli accordi di cooperazione scientifica e culturale stipulati dall'Università Ca' Foscari Venezia con Università internazionali consentono agli studenti dell'Ateneo di realizzare un'esperienza formativa di mobilità internazionale secondo l'organizzazione didattica dei corsi delle Università partner elencate nell'allegato "A - Destinazioni".
2. Le attività previste durante la mobilità consistono nella frequenza di corsi e sostenimento dei relativi esami presso le Università partner. Gli esami verranno convalidati e trascritti nel libretto online dello studente se preventivamente concordati con i docenti di Ca' Foscari, tramite compilazione di apposito Learning Agreement (il documento che riporta il piano di studi da seguire durante il periodo di mobilità internazionale). In aggiunta al sostenimento di esami, lo studente potrà effettuare attività di ricerca per la tesi (compilando l'apposito Learning Agreement). Non è prevista mobilità per la sola ricerca ai fini della tesi, fatta eccezione per i dottorandi.
3. I requisiti richiesti ai candidati sono definiti dai singoli Accordi di Cooperazione e secondo i criteri concordati con le Università ospitanti così come riportato nell'allegato "A - Destinazioni" alle quali spetta la definitiva ammissione dei vincitori proposti per i programmi di scambio.
4. **L'effettiva partenza dipenderà dalle misure sanitarie e dalle indicazioni delle autorità italiane competenti, dei Paesi di destinazione, degli Atenei ospitanti e di Ca' Foscari in relazione all'emergenza sanitaria collegata alla diffusione del Covid-19. Alla luce delle misure adottate dai singoli atenei ospitanti, i corsi potranno essere svolti anche online, in modalità a distanza.**

**Art. 2 - Destinatari del Bando**

1. Possono partecipare gli studenti di qualsiasi cittadinanza regolarmente iscritti per l'a.a. 2020/2021 all'Università Ca' Foscari Venezia, che:

- a) Siano iscritti al secondo o terzo anno di Corsi di Laurea (triennale) e abbiano ottenuto la verbalizzazione sul libretto online di almeno 36 CFU entro la mezzanotte del 10/01/2021 (non si accetteranno autocertificazioni per il sostenimento di esami non ancora verbalizzati);
- b) Siano iscritti a corsi di Laurea Magistrale con sede amministrativa presso l'Università Ca' Foscari Venezia (questi studenti saranno automaticamente ammessi alla selezione per il bando);
- c) Siano iscritti a corsi di Dottorato di Ricerca con sede amministrativa presso l'Università Ca' Foscari Venezia (saranno automaticamente ammessi alla selezione per il bando);

2. Tutti gli studenti delle categorie sopracitate devono risultare regolarmente iscritti ai corsi di laurea, laurea magistrale e dottorato entro la scadenza del presente Bando ed essere in regola con il pagamento delle tasse universitarie al momento della partenza e per tutta la durata della mobilità.

### **Art. 3 - Contributi alle spese offerti da Ca' Foscari**

1. Gli studenti vincitori del presente bando beneficeranno di un contributo a parziale copertura delle spese fino al massimale indicato nell' "Allegato B-Rimborso". Un ulteriore contributo di merito, in misura pari al 25% del contributo indicato nell' "Allegato B-Rimborso", sarà erogato agli studenti che otterranno un riconoscimento di almeno 12 CFU.

2. Il contributo sarà erogato al rientro dalla mobilità esclusivamente se lo studente:

- porterà a termine l'intero periodo di mobilità previsto dall'università ospitante e indicato nell'allegato "A - Destinazioni";
- consegnerà, a titolo di giustificativo delle spese sostenute fino al massimale previsto, uno o più dei seguenti documenti: biglietti di viaggio, spese certificate di alloggio, spese per il visto, assicurazioni sanitarie, trasporto da e per l'aeroporto, libri di testo, bollette intestate al vincitore del bando, abbonamenti a mezzi di trasporto;
- Sosterrà almeno 1 credito in mobilità, ad eccezione dei dottorandi;
- Consegnerà il modulo di riconoscimento di riconoscimento crediti;
- Compilerà il questionario finale che verrà inviato via e-mail;
- Consegnerà tutta la documentazione indicata alla pagina [www.unive.it/overseas](http://www.unive.it/overseas) (Conferma d'Arrivo, Learning Agreement ed eventuali variazioni, Conferma di Partenza);

- Osserverà tutti gli adempimenti descritti nel presente bando, pubblicati alla pagina [www.unive.it/overseas](http://www.unive.it/overseas) ed eventualmente comunicati via e-mail dall'Ufficio Relazioni Internazionali.

3. I contributi alla mobilità indicati nell'Allegato B-Rimborso Overseas" saranno erogati entro 45 giorni dalla presentazione della documentazione elencata al comma 2 del presente articolo esclusivamente sulla CartaConto di ateneo; sarà responsabilità dello studente attivare la carta.

#### **Art. 4 - Incentivi didattici**

1. Secondo le deliberazioni del Senato Accademico, agli studenti iscritti ai corsi di Laurea e di Laurea Magistrale che partecipano al programma Overseas e abbiano avuto il riconoscimento di almeno un esame equivalente a 6 CFU, saranno attribuiti i bonus sul punteggio finale di laurea. Tale bonus non viene assegnato agli studenti iscritti ad un programma che conferisce un diploma doppio o congiunto.

#### **Art. 5 - Modalità e termini di presentazione della candidatura**

1. Gli studenti interessati devono compilare la loro domanda online all'interno della propria Area Riservata nella sezione dedicata ai bandi di Mobilità, compilando tutti i campi e le sezioni richieste, **entro le ore 12.00 del 11/01/2021** pena esclusione.

2. Gli studenti possono indicare **fino a un massimo di 3 destinazioni**, indicando anche l'ordine di preferenza. **La scelta della destinazione dovrà essere effettuata in maniera coerente rispetto a quanto indicato nell'allegato "A - Destinazioni" e sul sito dell'università ospitante in termini di requisiti per l'ammissione alla mobilità e offerta formativa compatibile col proprio percorso di studi.**

3. I laureandi nella sessione straordinaria dei Corsi di Laurea, che non fossero tenuti al pagamento della prima rata per l'a.a. 2020/2021 e che di conseguenza non possono utilizzare la procedura online, possono comunque presentare domanda di partecipazione al bando. Essi sono tenuti a contattare entro le ore 12.00 dell'11/01/2021, pena esclusione, l'Ufficio Relazioni Internazionali-Settore Mobilità via e-mail all'indirizzo [overseasout@unive.it](mailto:overseasout@unive.it) (segnalando nell'oggetto: CANDIDATURA OVERSEAS 2021/2022 LAUREANDO): l'ufficio indicherà la procedura da seguire per l'iscrizione al bando. Essi dovranno poi risultare regolarmente iscritti ad un Corso di Laurea Magistrale al momento della partenza.

4. Gli iscritti a Corsi di Dottorato di Ricerca dovranno presentare –in aggiunta alla domanda online- una lettera del proprio Supervisore che certifica lo stato di avanzamento del proprio lavoro di ricerca, inviandola a [overseasout@unive.it](mailto:overseasout@unive.it) (segnalando nell'oggetto: CANDIDATURA OVERSEAS 2021/2022 DOTTORANDO) entro la medesima scadenza indicata al comma 1 del presente articolo, pena esclusione. La lettera del Supervisore è considerata parte integrante della candidatura, pertanto il mancato invio comporta l'esclusione dalle procedure di selezione.

5. Al fine di ricevere specifico supporto per la presentazione della domanda e per ricevere informazioni sui servizi messi a disposizione dalle università partner, i candidati con disabilità sono invitati a contattare l'Ufficio Relazioni Internazionali-Settore Mobilità con congruo anticipo rispetto alla scadenza del bando.

6. Eventuali segnalazioni di malfunzionamento dell'applicativo informatico per presentare la domanda verranno raccolte dall'Ufficio Relazioni Internazionali-Settore Mobilità entro la medesima data e ora di scadenza indicata al comma 1 del presente articolo. L'Ufficio valuterà l'opportunità o meno di accogliere ogni singola segnalazione.

7. Non verranno prese in considerazione domande erroneamente compilate o incomplete.

- Agli studenti iscritti al 1° anno dei Corsi di Laurea Magistrale che non abbiano crediti verbalizzati entro la mezzanotte del 10/01/2021 il dato della media verrà sostituito da quello del voto di Laurea (triennale) normalizzato in trentesimi. Agli studenti che per l'immatricolazione alla Magistrale abbiano presentato un titolo di studio straniero il dato della media verrà attribuito d'ufficio e corrisponderà alla performance media degli iscritti al corso di laurea Magistrale cui risultano iscritti nell'a.a. 2020/2021;
- A tutti gli studenti iscritti al 1° anno dei Corsi di Laurea Magistrale verrà attribuito un bonus sul punteggio finale calcolato in base al voto di laurea convertito in trentesimi, secondo il seguente schema:

### **Art.8 - Accettazione del posto**

1. L'accettazione del posto dovrà essere effettuata da parte dello studente vincitore entro le ore 12.00 del 02/02/2021, pena esclusione, compilando l'apposito modulo online disponibile al seguente link <https://forms.gle/LAYGmb3wAfqjWzNQ7>. Il semestre scelto in fase di accettazione non potrà essere modificato successivamente, a meno che non si verifichino cause di forza maggiore o la modifica sia proposta da Ca' Foscari o dall'Ateneo ospitante. Gli studenti iscritti al terzo anno di un Corso di Laurea che intendano laurearsi nella sessione autunnale del 2021 dovranno programmare il loro periodo di mobilità per il secondo semestre dell'a.a. 2021/2022, previa iscrizione alla Laurea Magistrale. Si consiglia di non pianificare la mobilità nel semestre in cui si prevede di laurearsi, perché i tempi di conclusione della mobilità potrebbero non consentirlo.
2. Le riserve non dovranno compilare il modulo di accettazione, ma verranno contattate esclusivamente via e-mail in caso di rinuncia da parte dei vincitori. Le riserve potranno essere convocate in caso di rinuncia da parte dei vincitori dal giorno successivo alla scadenza per l'accettazione del posto fino alla scadenza per le nomine definita dagli atenei partner. Tale scadenza varia a seconda della destinazione. Le riserve sono invitate a controllare con frequenza la casella di posta elettronica [matricola@stud.unive.it](mailto:matricola@stud.unive.it) dal momento che i termini per l'accettazione del posto potranno essere ravvicinati in base alle scadenze imposte dalle università ospitanti.
3. Nei primi mesi del 2021 è previsto un incontro informativo per gli studenti in partenza nell'a.a. 2021/2022 (la data verrà comunicata via email ai vincitori). Se l'emergenza legata alla diffusione del Covid - 19 dovesse perdurare, saranno adottate soluzioni alternative all'incontro in presenza.
4. Lo studente che rinuncia alla mobilità dopo l'accettazione del posto perderà il diritto a partecipare ai bandi Overseas 2022/2023, salvo documentate cause di forza maggiore.
5. Nel caso in cui l'Università ospitante richieda una certificazione linguistica a conferma di quanto autocertificato, questa dovrà essere presentata dal vincitore entro i termini stabiliti dall'università di destinazione stessa. Sarà responsabilità dello studente verificare requisiti e documenti richiesti dall'ateneo ospitante.

**L'accettazione definitiva del candidato sulla base della graduatoria stilata da Ca' Foscari spetta in ogni caso all'Università ospitante, che potrebbe inoltre modificare in qualsiasi momento il numero di studenti ammessi alla mobilità, anche in deroga a quanto indicato nell'allegato "A - Destinazioni".**

#### **Art. 9 - Status dei vincitori e mobilità**

1. Gli studenti ammessi allo scambio e accettati dall'Università ospitante mantengono lo status di studenti di Ca' Foscari e avranno al tempo stesso accesso a tutti i servizi che l'Università ospitante offre ai propri studenti. In particolare gli studenti saranno esentati dal pagamento delle tasse di iscrizione dell'Università ospitante e potranno essere ammessi, a loro spese, ai servizi di mensa e alloggio e quanto altro previsto dalla stessa Università. Alcune Università potrebbero richiedere allo studente un contributo per attività di orientamento obbligatorio, per l'assicurazione sanitaria, o altri servizi.
2. Gli studenti vincitori in partenza saranno responsabili, a loro spese, del visto per l'ingresso, della stipula e del pagamento degli importi delle assicurazioni internazionali (sanitarie o di altro tipo) eventualmente richieste dalle Università ospitanti. Queste ultime hanno facoltà di richiedere anche una certificazione medica relativa allo stato di salute dei candidati.
3. Gli studenti di cittadinanza extra UE dovranno accertarsi con congruo anticipo di essere in regola con il permesso di soggiorno in Italia ai fini della richiesta del visto per il Paese di destinazione, contattando l'indirizzo [immigrationteam@unive.it](mailto:immigrationteam@unive.it) non appena inviata la conferma di accettazione del posto.
4. Alcune Università ospitanti richiedono ai vincitori di dimostrare tramite certificazione finanziaria il possesso di fondi sufficienti al proprio mantenimento per il periodo di studio concordato.
5. Il periodo di mobilità non può essere anticipato o posticipato per poter partecipare alla sessione di esami o di laurea di Ca' Foscari.
6. Il periodo di mobilità potrebbe subire delle variazioni dovute a specifiche esigenze dell'Università ospitante.



7. Saranno valutate eventuali interruzioni e riprese della mobilità solo per cause di forza maggiore documentate. Le attività di mobilità di cui al presente bando non saranno garantite se gli stati di destinazione si troveranno in una situazione di rischio, definita come tale da apposito sito curato dal Ministero degli Affari Esteri e della Cooperazione Internazionale (<http://www.viaggiasesicuri.it>).

8. Durante il periodo di mobilità è severamente vietato sostenere esami a Ca' Foscari o conseguire il titolo finale di laurea, pena l'annullamento della mobilità e degli esami sostenuti.

9. Gli studenti con status di studente part – time che risulteranno vincitori dovranno cambiare il proprio status prima della partenza e risultare studenti full –time per tutta la durata della mobilità.

10. Sarà possibile svolgere un tirocinio durante il periodo di mobilità purché si tratti di un'attività promossa e patrocinata dall'università ospitante, preventivamente approvata dal Coordinatore del Collegio Didattico del proprio corso di laurea/ docente referente per la mobilità e compatibile con il proprio visto. Ai fini del riconoscimento, il tirocinio così definito dovrà essere inserito all'interno del Learning Agreement. Eventuali altre attività di tirocinio possono essere svolte prima o dopo il periodo obbligatorio di permanenza stabilito dall'università ospitante, ma non contemporaneamente.

**CALL FOR APPLICATION FOR OVERSEAS SELECTION 2021/2022 - OPPORTUNITIES  
TO STUDY ABROAD IN INTERNATIONAL EXCHANGE PROGRAMS**

***Art. 1 - Description***

1. The scientific and cultural cooperation agreements stipulated by Ca' Foscari University of Venice with other international universities offer University students a formative international mobility experience in accordance with the educational programmes of the partner universities listed in Attachment "A - destinations".
2. The activities planned during mobility consist in the attendance of courses and sitting of the relevant exams at the partner Universities. The exams will be validated and entered into the online student's record book if previously agreed with the professors at Ca' Foscari, by completing the appropriate Learning Agreement (the document that shows the study plan to be followed during the international mobility period). In addition to taking exams, the student can carry out research activities for the thesis (also filling out the appropriate Learning Agreement). There is no provision for exchange for research purposes only, except for PhD Students.
3. Candidates must possess the qualifications defined by the individual Cooperation Agreements, in accordance to the criteria agreed upon with the Host Universities as detailed in Attachment "A - Destinations". The definitive admission of the candidates selected for the exchange programs can be granted only by the Host Universities.
- 4. Departures will depend on the health measures and the indications given by the competent Italian authorities, Countries of destination, Host universities and Ca' Foscari University in relation to the emergency linked to the spread of Covid-19. Depending on host universities policies, courses could be provided online.**

***Art. 2 – Intended Recipients of this Call for application***

1. Students of any nationality who are regularly enrolled at Ca' Foscari University of Venice for the a.y. 2020/2021, and who:



- a) Are enrolled in the second or third year of a Bachelor's Degree Programme and have recorded in the online student's record at least 36 CFU by Midnight, January 11th 2021 (self-certification will not be accepted as a proof for exams not yet recorded);
  - b) Are enrolled in a Master's Degree Programme administered by Ca' Foscari University of Venice (these students will be automatically admitted to selection);
  - c) Are enrolled in a PhD (Doctoral Research) Programme administered by Ca' Foscari University of Venice (these students will be automatically admitted to selection).
2. All the students in the above mentioned categories must be regularly enrolled in an undergraduate, master's or PhD programme within the deadline set by this Call for Application and must be up to date with the payment of Ca' Foscari's University fees both at the time of departure and for the entire duration of the mobility period.

### ***Art. 3 - Contributions to the expenses offered by Ca' Foscari***

1. The winners of this Call for Application will receive a contribution to cover their expenses up to the maximum amount indicated in "Attachment B-Reimbursement". A further contribution of merit, equal to 25% of the contribution indicated in "Attachment B-Reimbursement", will be granted to students who will receive the recognition of at least 12 ECTS credits.
2. The contribution will be paid upon return from the exchange programme only if the student:
  - completes the entire period of mobility defined by the host university and indicated in Attachment "A - Destinations";
  - delivers one or more of the following documents as proof of expenses incurred up to the maximum amount provided: travel tickets, certified accommodation expenses, visa fees, health insurances, transport to and from the airport, textbooks, bills in the name of the winner of the call for application, etc.;
  - take at least 1 credit during the mobility period, except for PhD Students;
  - provides the Credit Recognition Form;
  - fills out the final questionnaire that will be sent via e-mail;
  - delivers all the documentation indicated at [www.unive.it/overseas](http://www.unive.it/overseas) (Confirmation of Arrival, Learning Agreement, Changes to the Learning Agreement, if any, and Confirmation of Departure);



- fulfils all the requirements detailed in this Call for Application , published at [www.unive.it/overseas](http://www.unive.it/overseas) and possibly communicated via e-mail by the International Relations Office.

All the above documentation must be scanned and sent to [overseasout@unive.it](mailto:overseasout@unive.it) as soon as possible, and in any case strictly by:

- June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022 for mobility carried out in the first semester;
- November 15<sup>th</sup>, 2022 for mobility carried out in the second semester.

3. The mobility contributions indicated in "Attachment B-Overseas Reimbursement" will be issued within 45 days of the presentation of the documentation listed in paragraph 2 of the present article and only on the University Account Card; it will be the student's responsibility to activate the card before departure.

#### ***Art. 4 - Educational incentives***

1. According to the decisions of the Academic Senate, students enrolled in Bachelor's and Master's degree Programmes who participate in the Overseas program and obtain the recognition of least one exam, corresponding to 6 CFU, will be awarded a bonus on the final degree score. This bonus is not awarded to students enrolled in a program that confers a double or joint degree.

#### ***Art. 5 - Methods and terms of application submission***

1. Students interested in the selection must complete their application online, by accessing their Personal Area > Mobilità internazionale > Bandi di mobilità. Students must fill in all the required fields and sections, **by 12:00pm (noon) on January 11th 2021**, under penalty of exclusion.

2. Students can select **up to a maximum of 3 destinations**, also indicating the order of preference. The choice of the destinations must be consistent with what indicated in the



Attachment "A - Destinations" and on the website of the Host University, in terms of requirements for admission to the Exchange Program and academic offer. The academic offer of the Host University must indeed be compatible with the course of study.

3. Students graduating in the extraordinary session of the degree programme, who were not required to pay the first instalment for the academic year 2020/2021 and who consequently cannot use the online procedure, can still participate in the present call. They must contact the International Relations Office-Mobility Unit by 12:00 pm on January 11<sup>th</sup>, 2021 via the address [overseasout@unive.it](mailto:overseasout@unive.it) (indicating as subject: OVERSEAS CANDIDATURE 2021/2022 GRADUATE) the office will indicate the procedure to be followed to register for the call for application. Winners must be regularly enrolled in a Master's Degree Programme by the time of departure.

4. Students enrolled in a PhD courses must submit - in addition to the online application - a letter from their Supervisor certifying the progress of their research work. The letter must be sent to [overseasout@unive.it](mailto:overseasout@unive.it) (indicating as subject: OVERSEAS CANDIDATURE 2021/2022 PhD) within the same deadline indicated in paragraph 1 of this article. Letter from Supervisor is an integral part of the application, therefore failure to send the letter will imply the exclusion from selection procedures.

5. In order to receive specific support in the presentation of the application and to receive information on the services made available by the partner universities, candidates with disabilities are invited to contact the International Relations Office-Mobility Unit well in advance of the deadline of the call.

6. Any reports of technical malfunctions in the online application will be collected by the International Relations Office-Mobility Unit by the same deadline and date of the present Call for application, indicated in paragraph 1 of this article. The Office will consider whether or not to accept each individual report.

7. Erroneous or incomplete applications will not be considered.



### **Art. 6 - Selection of applications**

1. The Mobility Unit will draw up a ranking based on the following criteria:

- For students enrolled in undergraduate and master's degree programmes: average and career speed (in case of equal-merit, the motivational letter will also be evaluated) recorded by Midnight, January 10th 2021;
- For students enrolled in the 1st year of a Master's Degree Programme who do not possess a written record by Midnight on January 10th 2021 the average will be replaced by the Bachelor's Degree final grade normalized into thirtieths. For students who submit a foreign qualification for enrolment in the Master's Degree, the average figure will be attributed ex officio and will correspond to the average performance of the students enrolled in the Master's degree program, in which they are enrolled in the academic year 2020/2021;
- All students enrolled in the 1st year of the Master's Degree Programmes will receive a bonus on the final score calculated on the basis of the degree mark converted into thirtieths, according to the following scheme:

degree mark converted into thirtieths	bonus
From 18 to 22,99	2 Points
From 23 to 27,99	5 Points
From 28 to 30L	10 Points

- For students enrolled in a PhD programme: motivational letter and letter of the Supervisor;
- Students who did not participate in an Overseas exchange programme will be assigned 1 extra-point in the final ranking, aimed at encouraging mobility abroad.

2. The ranking will be drawn up based on the score obtained and the preferences expressed by the students. Each student can be a winner for only one destination or a reserve for multiple destinations. Winners will not be included in the reserve lists.



### ***Art. 7 - Ranking***

1. **The rankings will be published in the Personal Area at [www.unive.it](http://www.unive.it) by January 29th 2021.** Any postponements of the ranking list will be notified on the website [www.unive.it/overseas](http://www.unive.it/overseas).
2. It is the responsibility of each candidate to consult the rankings.

### ***Art.8 - Acceptance of the place***

1. **Formal acceptance of a place must be made by the winning student by 12:00pm (noon), February 2nd 2021,** under penalty of exclusion, by filling out the appropriate online form available at the following link <https://forms.gle/LAYGmb3wAfqiWzNQ7>. The semester cannot be modified later, unless in cases of force majeure or if the change is proposed by Ca' Foscari or by the host university. Students enrolled in the third year of a Bachelor's Degree Programme who intend to graduate in the autumn session of 2021 will have to plan their mobility period for the second semester of the academic year 2021/2022, upon enrolment in a Master's Degree Programme. We suggest not to plan the mobility in the same semester of graduation, because credit recognition process requires time.
2. Students in the reserve list will not have to fill in the acceptance form, but will be contacted by email only, in the event that any winners should withdraw. Reserves may be called in case of withdrawal by the winners starting from the day after the deadline for the acceptance of a place up until the deadline for the nominations defined by partner universities. This deadline varies depending on the destination. Reserves are invited to frequently check the inbox at [matricola@stud.unive.it](mailto:matricola@stud.unive.it) as the time limits for acceptance of a place may be brought closer to the deadlines imposed by the host universities.
3. Early 2021 there will be an informative meeting for the students who will start their mobility period in the academic year 2021/2022 (the date will be communicated via email to shortlisted students).





4. The student who withdraws from the mobility after formally accepting the place will lose the right to participate in the Overseas calls for application for the a.y. 2022/2023, except for documented evidence of force majeure.
5. In the event that the Host University requires a linguistic certification confirming self-certification, this must be presented by the winner within the terms established by the Host University itself. It will be the student's responsibility to verify the requirements and documents required by the Host University.

**The definitive acceptance of the candidate on the basis of the ranking drawn up by Ca' Foscari is in any case granted by the Host University, which could also modify at any time the number of students admitted to the Exchange Programme, also in derogation of what is indicated in attachment "A - Destinations".**

#### ***Art. 9 - Status of winners and mobility***

1. The Students admitted to the exchange and accepted by the Host University maintain the status of Ca' Foscari students and will have access to all the services that the host university offers to their students. In particular, students will be exempted from paying tuition fees to the host university and may be admitted, at their own expense, to canteen and accommodation services and anything else provided by the University itself. Some Universities may require the student to pay extra-fees for compulsory orientation activities, health insurance, or other services.
2. The winners will be responsible, at their expense, for the entry, signing and payment of the amounts of international insurance (health or other) that may possibly be requested by the host universities. The latter have the right to request a medical certification concerning the health status of the candidates.
3. Students holding a non-EU citizenship must make sure that they are in good standing with their residence permit in Italy for the purpose of applying for a visa for the destination country. To do so, upon formally accepting the place, they must contact [immigrationteam@unive.it](mailto:immigrationteam@unive.it).



4. Some Host Universities may require winners to demonstrate, through a financial certification, the possession of sufficient funds for self-maintenance for the agreed period of study.
5. The mobility period cannot be brought forward or postponed in order to participate in Ca' Foscari University of Venice exams or degree session.
6. The mobility period may be subject to variations due to specific needs of the host University.
7. Possible interruptions and resumed mobility will be assessed only for reasons of documented force majeure. The mobility activities referred to in this call for applications will not be guaranteed if there is a security risk in the destination countries, defined as such by the website managed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation (<https://www.viaggiasesicuri.it>).
8. During mobility period it is strictly forbidden to take exams at Ca' Foscari or to obtain the final degree, under penalty of cancellation of the mobility and exams taken.
9. It is possible to carry out a traineeship during the mobility period, provided that the traineeship is promoted and supported by the Host University, that it is pre-approved by the Teaching Committee Coordinator of the student's Degree Programme/by the professor in charge and that it is compatible with the student's visa. In order to obtain the recognition of the traineeship, the student must include it in the Learning Agreement. Any other traineeship can be carried out before or after the mandatory period of stay established by the Host University.
10. If selected for the exchange program, part-time students will have to change their status to full-time students before departure and maintain the full-time students status for the entire mobility period.
11. Exchange students must register on the portal of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation <https://www.dovesiamonelmondo.it> .
12. Students must comply with all the procedures indicated at <http://www.unive.it/overseas> and also possibly communicated via email from the Mobility Section.
