

# ARCA: FILES UPLOADING

Make the right choice

## 1. Select the version of the file

T Y P E	<b>Pre-print version</b>	The <b>submitted version</b> or author's original draft that has <b>not been peer-reviewed</b> nor had any value added by the publisher (such as formatting or copy editing).
	<b>Post-print version</b>	The <b>accepted (peer-reviewed) version</b> or final draft that incorporates all amendments made during the peer review process, but prior to the final published version (without the publisher's layout). Most of the publishers consent to self-archive post-print versions in institutional repositories like ARCA, often after a period of embargo.
	<b>Published version</b>	The <b>version of record</b> or the final typeset and edited version of the article that has been made available by the editor by formally and exclusively declaring the article "published". Always select this option if the publisher is <b>Edizioni Ca' Foscari</b> .
	<b>Other type</b>	Audio/video file, etc.

## 2. Select the policy access of the file

L O G I N  S E T T I N G S	<b>open access</b>	The file is <b>available online</b> ; the rights management will be specified at the next step ( <i>license</i> ). Always select this option if the publisher is <b>Edizioni Ca' Foscari</b> .
	<b>embargo date</b>	During the embargo period the <b>file is not accessible</b> (but metadata are always available). At the end of this period, the file will be <i>open access</i> . Max period of embargo: 12 months (see <a href="#">Regolamento di Ateneo per il deposito in ARCA</a> ), unless exceptions.
	<b>restricted access</b>	The <b>file is accessible only to the author(s)</b> , internal co-authors, authorized University staff.













### 3. Select the license of the file

By choosing <b>open access</b> or <b>embargo date</b> as 'login settings', the following 4 options appear in the 'license' field:	
<b>Accesso libero (no vincoli) / Free access (no restriction)</b>	This license allows <b>free access and reuse</b> of the file while respecting intellectual property.
<b>Accesso gratuito (solo visione) / Free access (read only)</b>	This license allows <b>free access but no changes or adaptations</b> of the file are permitted.
<b><u> Pubblco dominio / Public Domain</u></b>	<b>No right is reserved to the author</b> , so it is allowed to copy, modify, distribute and perform the file even for commercial purposes without need of any permission.
<b>L I C E N S E</b>  <b><u>Creative commons (CC)</u></b>	<p>Creative Commons licenses give a standardized way to grant the public permission to use a creative work under copyright law. There are six different license types:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Attribution (CC-BY)</b>: this license allows reusers to distribute, remix, adapt, and build upon the material in any medium or format, so long as attribution is given to the creator. The license allows for commercial use.</li> <li>• <b>Attribution-ShareAlike (CC BY-SA)</b>: this license allows reusers to distribute, remix, adapt, and build upon the material in any medium or format, so long as attribution is given to the creator. The license allows for commercial use. If you remix, adapt, or build upon the material, you must license the modified material under identical terms.</li> <li>• <b>Attribution-NoDerivs (CC BY-ND)</b>: this license allows reusers to copy and distribute the material in any medium or format in unadapted form only, and only so long as attribution is given to the creator. The license allows for commercial use.</li> <li>• <b>Attribution-NonCommercial (CC BY-NC)</b>: this license allows reusers to distribute, remix, adapt, and build upon the material in any medium or format for noncommercial purposes only, and only so long as attribution is given to the creator.</li> <li>• <b>Attribution-NonCommercial-ShareAlike (CC BY-NC-SA)</b>: this license allows reusers to distribute, remix, adapt, and build upon the material in any medium or format for noncommercial purposes only, and only so long as attribution is given to the creator. If you remix, adapt, or build upon the material, you must license the modified material under identical terms.</li> <li>• <b>Attribution-NonCommercial-NoDerivs (CC BY-NC-ND)</b>: this license allows reusers to copy and distribute the material in any medium or format in unadapted form only, for noncommercial purposes only, and only so long as attribution is given to the creator.</li> </ul> <p>Always select 'Creative commons' if the publisher is <b>Edizioni Ca' Foscari</b>. Then select <b>"Yes"</b> in the license questions that appear when you select this option. The <b>Attribution (CC-BY) license</b> will be displayed.</p>

By choosing 'restricted access' as 'login settings', the following 2 options appear in the 'license' field:	
<b>Accesso chiuso-personale / Close access</b>	The file is accessible only to the authors, internal co-authors and the authorized University staff (including the Departmental commission members in case of internal evaluation procedures) by choice of the author.
<b>Copyright dell'editore / Publisher's Copyright</b>	The file is accessible only to the authors, internal co-authors and the authorized University staff (including the Departmental commission members in case of internal evaluation procedures) and is subject to specific usage rights defined by the publisher.
