(b) Training activities coming from:

- achievement of another degree, university master's degree, PhD;
- withdrawal or lapse from previous university programmes;
- single courses taken prior to enrolment for the purposes of attribuiting the bonus.

For the purpose of awarding the bonus each year of **part-time enrolment** is counted as half year of full-time enrolment.

Students participating in international programmes aimed at granting **Double/Joint Degree** will not be awarded bonuses relating to mobilities programmes. But they will be awarded the bonuses relating to the duration of the bachelor's degree (i.e. punti velocità) and the bonuses for the abroad internship, only if it has not been completed during the Joint/Double Degree programme

## About internship abroad:

- bonus points are awarded for internships and substitute internship activities completed abroad:
- any internship completed in a country that differs from the student's country of residence or domicile is considered an internship abroad, regardless of the student's nationality;
- an internship completed partly in person (abroad) and partly remotely is considered an internship abroad:
- bonus points are awarded for internship activities involving at least a one-month stay abroad;
- bonus is excluded for degree programmes that provide for compulsory internship.
