

## Bonus for the calculation of the final Bachelor's Degree grade for students enrolled from the 2021/22 cohort

The different types of bonuses can be cumulated except for Joint/Double degree program, for which only the bonuses indicated above will be applied

Foreign internship	Internship abroad <sup>(d)</sup>	2 points	

- "normal" enrolled students are those who enrol without the recognition of any course credits, including those transferring from another university who make a change of course within the Ca' Foscari educational offer;
- training activities coming from:
  - achievement of another degree, university master's degree, PhD;
  - withdrawal or lapse from previous university programmes;
  - single courses taken prior to enrolment;
- for the purposes of attributing the bonus, each year of part-time enrolment is counted as half year of full-time enrolment
- Internship:

- Bonus points are awarded for internships and substitute internship activities completed abroad;
- any internship completed in a country that differs from the student's country of residence or domicile is considered an internship abroad, regardless of the student's nationality;
- an internship completed partly in person (abroad) and partly remotely is considered an internship abroad;
- bonus points are awarded for internship activities involving at least a one-month stay abroad;
- bonus is excluded for degree programmes that provide for compulsory internship
