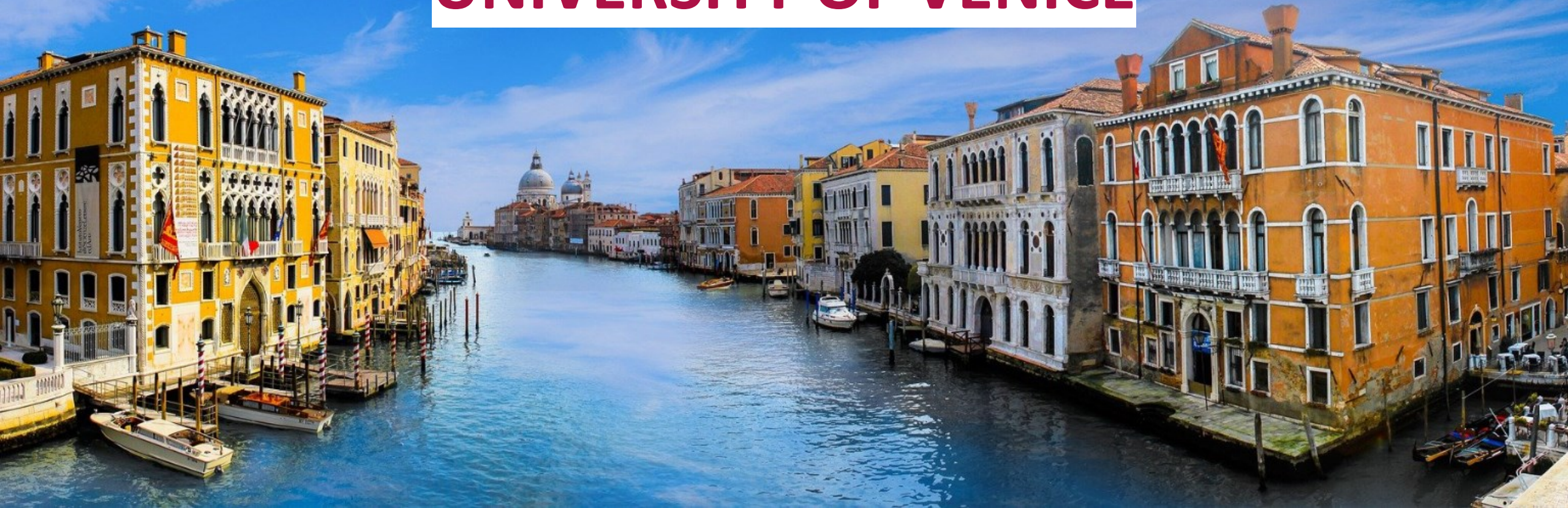

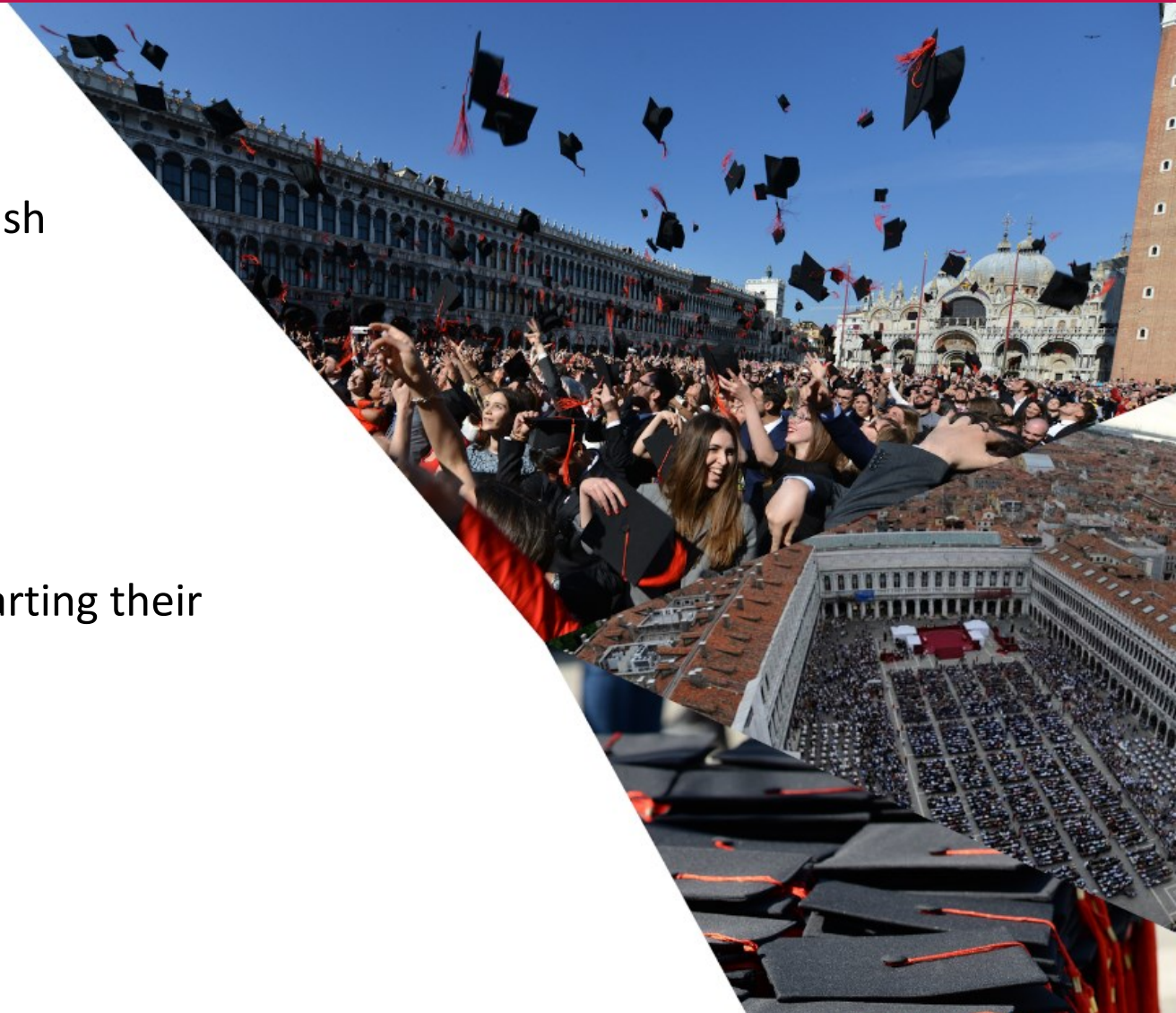


Who is a Degree Seeking student?

- 2-years master's degree programme
- Joint or Double bachelor's or master's degree starting their programme in Venice

1. Application on apply.unive.it;
2. Evaluation of the entry requirements;
3. Reception of the Letter of enrolment eligibility;
4. (ONLY for NON-EU students residing abroad) Pre-enrolment request on University and VISA application;
5. **Enrolment at Ca' Foscari University!**



Procedures, deadlines and fees for enrolment vary depending on where students come from:

- **EU students and equivalent** are citizens from European Member States and from Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Swiss Confederation, Republic of San Marino, Holy See and citizens of non-EU countries regularly residing in Italy (i.e. holding a permit of stay valid for enrolment).
- **Non-EU students who require a visa** are citizens of non-European countries who require a visa for long-term stay in Italy valid for enrolment.

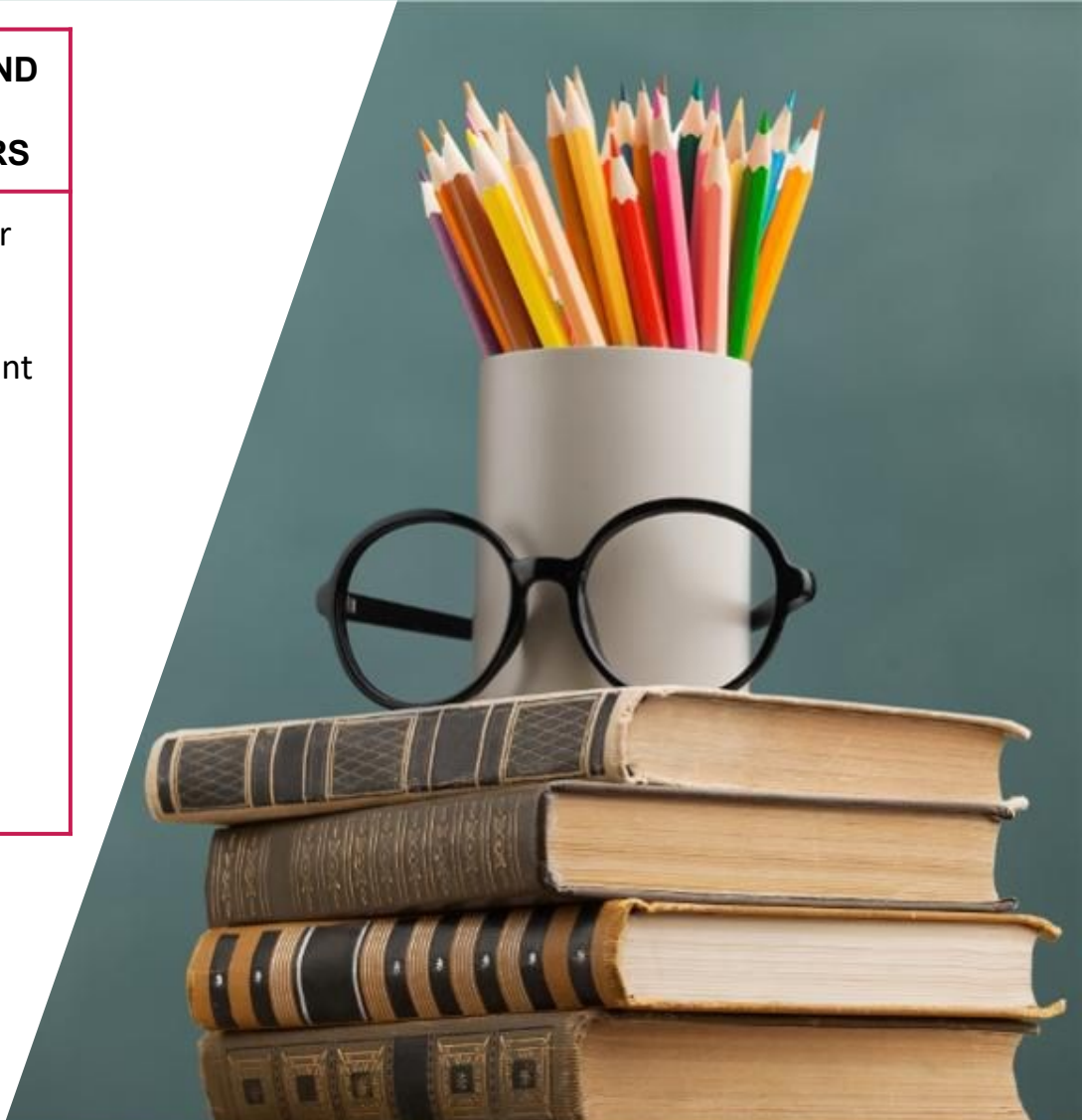

Academic Year

- The academic year, the period in which courses and exams take place, **begins in September and ends in August of the following year.**
- It is divided into **two semesters**, and, for Economics and Management, Arts and Humanities and Public Policy and Social Change only, these two semester are divided into two more periods.

Study plan, classes and exams: an overview

Campuses are in charge of this matters, if you have any questions, contact them!

- You can start **attending classes** even if your enrolment has not been finalised, using the **provisional login information**.
- Your **study plan** is the **list of learning activities** that you have to take. It has to be filled out in your Reserved Area in order to register to exams.
- **To take exams** you must be **enrolled** and you have to **register** online in your Reserved Area during the due registration periods.
- For each activity you will have to pass an exam with a **passing grade**. The **Italian grading system** works on a scale from **18** (minimum) to **30** (maximum).
- **Once you receive a grade** for the exam, you have either **to accept or refuse it**. Keep in mind that if you do anything, the grade will register automatically.
- **Only if you pass the exam** of a course will you obtain the **relevant credits** (CFU). Exams usually give 6 or 12 credits (CFU).

CartaConto (student card)

- The **CartaConto** is your **student ID** and you can use it to **access University services**, such as:
 - access University libraries and request books;
 - make photocopies;
 - get student discounts (where available) in public transport, museums, ...
- Ca' Foscari has an **agreement with Gruppo Crédit Agricole Italia**, therefore, if you wish to, you can **activate it as a prepaid card** and use it to make and receive payments.
- It will be ready approximately **3 weeks after the finalization of your enrollment**: you will receive an email by the Immigration Team with all instructions on how to collect it.



You are highly recommended to activate it in order to receive the scholarship or any fee refund you might need!

Enrolment certificate: what do I need it for?

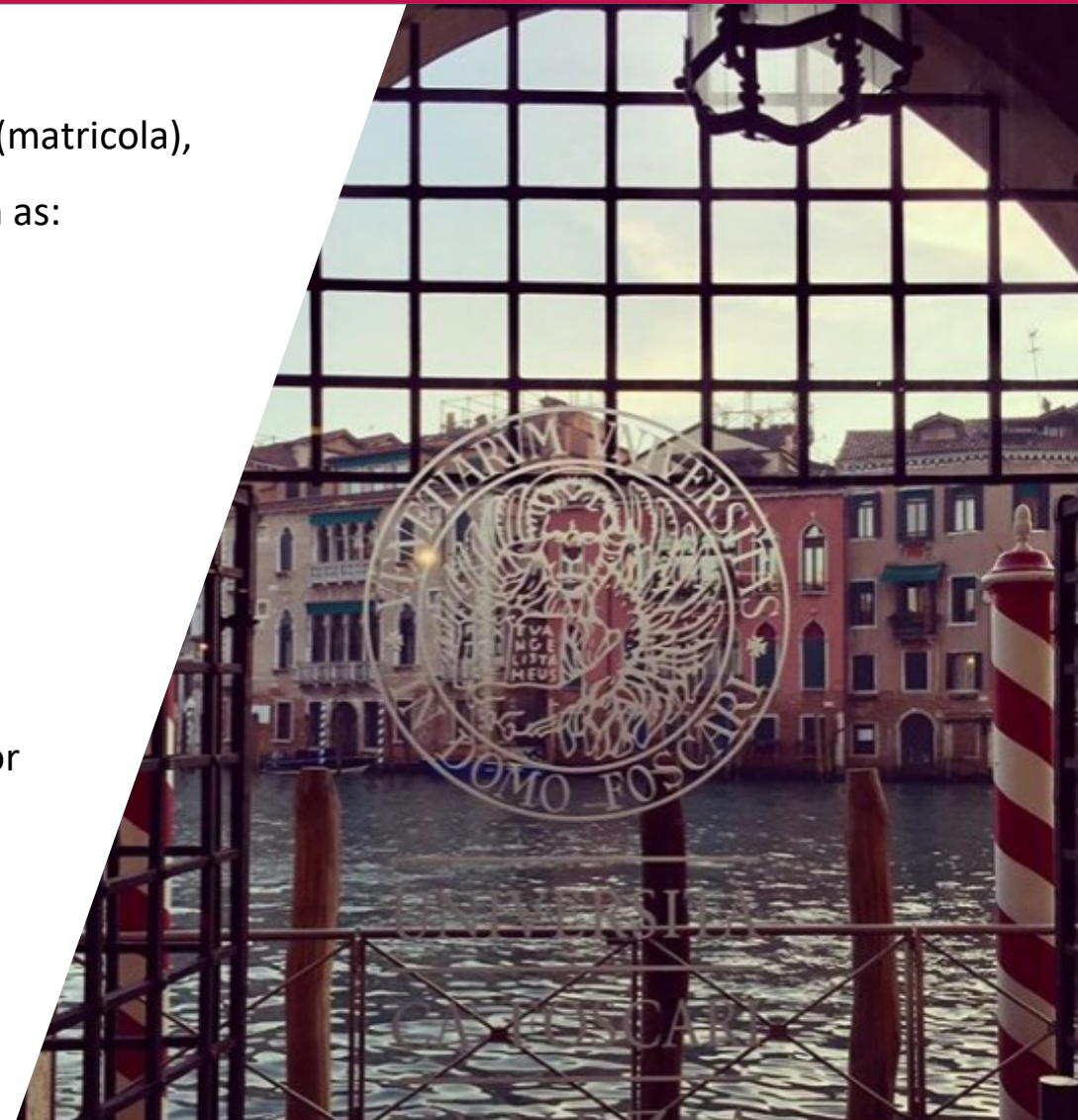

Once your enrolment is finalized and you have received your student number (matricola), you can **request the enrolment certificate** for administrative procedures, such as:

- Residence permit application (issued in Italian by the Welcome Unit)
- Enrollment in the National Health System
- Venezia è Unica Card (public transport)
- Opening a bank account in Italy

The **Welcome Unit** issues enrolment certificates only in Italian language and for immigration purposes (above-mentioned).

If you need officialized certificates for other purposes or in English you should request it to the [Student Administration BA and MA](#) desk.



Italian Residence Permit

Non-EU citizens staying more than 3 months in Italy must apply for a **Residence Permit** (*Permesso di Soggiorno*), even if they have a long term visa.

Non-European students can decide to either enroll the National Health System or purchase a private health insurance.

- The **Italian National Health Service** will guarantee you the same services as Italian citizens.
Here there is a [checklist](#) explaining in detail the registration procedure, for further info also check our [Students: your stay, insurance, transports](#).
- A **private health insurance** is also accepted, but you must inform yourself about registration procedures. Keep in mind that it must meet the following requirements:
 - it must be valid in Italy;
 - it must cover the risk of illness and accident;
 - it must be made out in your name;
 - it must be valid at least one year.

European students holding the the [European Health Insurance Card \(EHIC\)](#) are covered by the Italian National Health Service for all basic healthcare.





Tax code (Italian *Codice Fiscale*)

- The Italian *Codice Fiscale* is personal for every individual and it consists of a code of 16 alphanumeric characters;
- The *Codice fiscale* is valid only if released by the Italian Embassy/Consulate or by Agenzia delle Entrate (Italian Revenue Agency);
- The tax code you received while applying on apply.unive.it and/or on University is **only provisional, it is not the official one**;
- It is compulsory to **register accommodation contracts, open bank accounts, and receive scholarships or payments in Italy.**

How to write *proper* emails to Ca' Foscari's staff and professors

DOs:

- Use your institutional email MATRICOLA@stud.unive.it;
- Identify yourself by name, surname and matricola number;
- Be polite and wait patiently for an answer: professors and staff are people too :)
- Explain in detail what you are writing for and the problem you are facing;
- You can write either in English or Italian language.

DON'Ts:

- Use different personal email addresses;
- Assume that professors and staff remember everything about you;
- Use slang or abbreviations: it is a formal email and we don't know each other;
- Forward the same email or reply after some hours/days;
- Wait last minute: usually an answer will come in 7 working days.

How to book an appointment

- Until now, you have been in touch mainly with the staff of the Welcome Unit, but during your study path you will probably need to talk to **other offices' staff**.
- It is always **mandatory to book an appointment** to meet both professors and administrative staff.
- Appointments will be available mainly **online**.
- On [unive.it/myreservations](https://www.unive.it/myreservations) log-in with your Ca' Foscari credentials (even your provisional ones) and select the office or **the service you need**.
- If you cannot find an available slot, it means that they all have already been booked. Please **wait for the next appointment** to be available online or write an email.
- Note that you can't be attended if you come to any office **without an appointment**.
