

### Exam Registration and Grades

To take exams you have to register online during the due **registration periods,** <u>at least 4/3 days before the exam</u> <u>date</u>!

Please, mind that you will receive an email at your Ca' Foscari account (matriculation number@stud.unive.it) about either accepting or not accepting your exam results.

#### <u>DOs:</u>

Dear Professor (use their surname), Good morning. My name is NAME, matricola 889988, and I'm an exchange student from YOUR UNIVERSITY. My major is (major). ----- ask them your questions **politely** -----I look forward to talking to you soon. Best, YOUR NAME

- Formal greetings are important!
- Remember Professors are people too
- If they don't reply immediately, they're most likely busy. Try again later, and be polite!

#### DON'Ts:

*Hello Prof. (name), I have a question for u:* your question follows.

Can you let me know please because I'm busy and I need an answer thanks. Btw class was great last Thursday, see you. YOUR NAME

- Refrain from using slang or abbreviations; this is a formal email, not twitter dot com
- If you have feedback on the class make sure you address it properly

### **Grading System**

The Italian grading system works on a scale from **18** to **30**. 18 is the lowest passing grade (sufficiency). 30L is the highest grade (30 cum laude).

**ONLY** if you pass the exam of a course will you obtain the relevant credits. Exams usually give 6 or 12 credits.

If you do not pass an exam, you can retake it! Remember to check your personal email to accept or not the grade!

If you do not pass an exam, this cannot be registered in the online booklet, nor in the Transcript of Records. Therefore, you will not obtain credits.

<u>Please, mind that the end of your mobility corresponds to</u> <u>your last academic activity at Ca' Foscari!</u>



### **Italian Residence Permit**

**Non-EU citizens** staying more than 3 months in Italy must apply for a **Residence Permit** (*Permesso di Soggiorno*), even if they have a long term visa.

How to request the residence permit:

#### CartaConto

- The <u>CartaConto</u> is your student ID and you can use it to access University services, such as:
  - access University libraries and request books;
  - make photocopies;
  - get student discounts (where available) in public transport, museums, ...



- Ca' Foscari has an agreement with Gruppo Crédit Agricole Italia, therefore, if you wish to, you can activate it as a prepaid card and use it to make and receive payments.
- You will receive an email by the Immigration Team with all instructions on how to collect it.



### Health insurance

**Non-European students** can decide to either enroll the National Health System or purchase a private health insurance.

The **Italian National Health Service** will guarantee you the same services as Italian citizens. Here there is a <u>checklist</u> explaining in detail the registration procedure, for further info also check our <u>Students: your stay, insurance, transports</u>.

A **private health insurance** is also accepted, but you must inform yourself about registration procedures. Keep in mind that it must meet the following requirements:

- it must be valid in Italy;
- it must cover the risk of illness and accident;
- it must be made out in your name;
- it must be valid until the end of your stay.

**European students** holding the the <u>European Health Insurance Card (EHIC)</u> are covered by the Italian National Health Service for all basic healthcare.



### Tax code (codice fiscale)

- The Italian *Codice Fiscale* is personal for every individual and it consists of a code of 16 alphanumeric characters;
- The *Codice fiscale* is valid only if released by the Italian Embassy/Consulate or by Agenzia delle Entrate (Italian Revenue Agency);
- The tax code you received on Universitaly is only provisional, it is not the official one;
- It is compulsory to register accommodation contracts, open bank accounts, and receive scholarships or payments in Italy.
