## INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

Pursuant to and in accordance with Article 13 of the EU Regulation 2016/679 ("Regulation"), we inform you that:

- e) where personal data fall into categories referred to in Article 9 of the aforementioned EU Regulation, all measures will be taken to ensure their accuracy, integrity, confidentiality and minimization, as well as to prevent their undue disclosure;
- f) the data will be processed and retained for the time necessary to enable the completion of the project activities referred to in letter (c) above, as well as to comply with the controls required by current regulations. In any case, they will be kept for the time stipulated by the regulations in force regarding the storage and archiving of administrative documentation;
- g) the personal data referred to in letter (c) will be processed by means of paper and computer tools and may be made available to national and/or EU public subjects/Authorities for the performance of the controls required by law and to subjects offering instrumental and ancillary services to the University appointed as 'data processors'.
