

LEARNING AGREEMENT

Where can I find the PDF version of the Learning Agreement form?

Is the OLA only for Erasmus+ students?

Yes, it is. Erasmus ICM, Overseas and SEMP students have to submit the document via email in pdf format.

When is the deadline for submitting the Learning Agreement with eventual changes?

The deadline is October 8th, but we are willing to be flexible should your situation require it.

If my Learning Agreement has been signed already, do I need to use a different form in order to change it?

If you are using the OLA platform, please access the website and input the changes in the right section. For PDF documents, you will need to either input the changes in the right Table on your original document (Erasmus+ and ICM) or submit the Changes to Learning Agreement form (Overseas and SEMP).

Do I need to edit the LA if I don't want to change course?

No.

COURSES AND EXAMS

When are we expected to sign up for exams?

You will receive an email in due time with the instructions on how to sign up. The signing up time frame generally opens two weeks before the exam date.

How many ECTS should I take? Is there a maximum/minimum amount of workload required?

In order to receive your Transcript of Records, you must complete at least one exam (generally 6ECTS). You do not have a limit on the number of ECTS you can take, but we suggest taking no more than 30 ECTS per semester (roughly 4 to 5 exams).

Can I take courses that belong to a different year from the one I am currently in? (Ex.g. I am a second year but I want to take a first year course at Ca' Foscari University)

Yes. In addition, MA students can take Bachelor degree level courses, and BA students can take Master's degree level courses, as long as the home university approves the selection.
