



The conference ***Migrants within the city. Gender, social spaces, narratives*** discusses the final results of two linked research projects: *Conditions for Recognition, Gender, Migrations, Social Spaces (PRIN)* of the Universities of Padua, Venice Ca' Foscari, Florence, Milano Bicocca, Roma Tre and *Translocational positionality and multi-layered citizenship in Europe: everyday life strategies of migrant families across borders* ("Young researchers project 2010" University of Padua and CCIAA of Padua).

The city is considered as a privileged social context for the analysis of the new intersections of substantive citizenship. The every-day life of migrant women and men and their families – that embeds work and care relations, transits and spaces of aggregation and use of the institutions – has contributed to redefine the meaning of the places for everyone, from "the feeling of home" to the territories recognized as physical and symbolic homeland or as land of exile.

Following the intersectionality and biographical theoretical approaches, conveners will examine the combinations between the access to rights and material/symbolic resources and the processes of belonging and inclusion. These combinations also define meanings, practices and social hierarchies connected with gender, class and cultural-linguistic belongings.
