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HI-TEACH

Project Description

The HI-TEACH project proposes to strengthen university academic skills and knowledge by gaining experience from the period of the covid 19 pandemic, where many faculties and students found themselves using digital and adapting to the situation using the online method. The project proposes to take the opportunity to turn this emergency period into a great opportunity for better use of digital by both faculty and students at universities.

The Project's objectives will be achieved by realizing the following activities:

- 1) Develop for the benefit of EU teachers involved, the technological skills and methodologies to manage learning processes through digital solutions and behavioral qualities of resilience, flexibility and adaptation to change to build a permanent just-in-time, flexible, learner-centered digital teaching tools, to promote digital integration in learning with the adoption of smart e-learning solutions, to disseminate design and teaching skills.
- 2) Align 50 teachers of the partnership, involved in a transnational mobility, to acquire and transfer methodologies, such as: Game based learning, Movie editing and instructional design.
- 3) To nourish and keep alive over time a process of innovation in a digital key models of university teaching with the development of a methodological manual that guide the integrated digital didactics of the Hi-Teacher.
- 4) Aliment and maintain over time, a process of innovation in a digital key of university teaching models by creating a methodological manual that guides the integrated digital teaching of the Hi-Teacher.

Expected results

The project includes 3 main Intellectual Outputs:

1 HI-TEACH LEARNING PROGRAMM : DOING DIGITAL EDUCATION 4.0, Includes the following integrated activities:

- **Field Analysis** : It will start from the listening of a panel of key people conducted through Focus Groups.
- **Learning program** : On the basis of the findings, the experts of the partnership will design the new training program, defining the teaching methods, the criteria for the selection of teachers.
- **Testing**: by n. 50 teachers from Italy, Greece, Spain, Slovenia and Poland involved in and educational path articulated on the following 3 dimensions: Cognitive, Operational and Behavioral.

2 OER FOR THE HI TEACHER, Divided into two phases:

- **PROCESSING OF LEARNING CONTENT**: Based on the Learning Programme (I01), partners will develop OER content related to the target competencies related to the following thematic areas: Digital Didactic and Personal Empowerment .
- **OER development**: The OER will be developed in the form of interactive video training pills, which combine entertainment and learning and increase the involvement of beneficiaries (immersive education) maximizing the effectiveness of learning even after the end of the project.

3 HI-TEACH HANDBOOK: The partners will co-develop a methodological manual to evolve the teacher into the role of the Hi-TEACHER and guide them in drawing from instructional design and integrating game-based learning and movie education into distance learning classes to engage, excite and motivate students while maximizing the effectiveness and inclusiveness of integrated digital teaching (DDI).

The University of Salerno (“UNISA”) is ideally linked to the oldest academic institution in the Old Continent: the Schola Medica Salernitana. Founded in the eighth century AD, the School reached its peak between the 10th and 13th century. In addition to medicine, its lectures included philosophy, theology and law. The School, which earned Salerno the title of Hippocratica Civitas (City of Hippocrates) after the famous Greek physician and treatise writer, was closed by royal decree in 1811 under Joachim Murat’s Napoleonic government. In 1944, by decree of king Victor Emmanuel III, the Istituto Universitario di Magistero “Giovanni Cuomo” was founded. This became state-owned in 1968, changing its name into Facoltà di Magistero dell’Università degli Studi di Salerno. Within a few years, the Faculty was joined by many others, which contributed to the formation of a major university. The Faculty of Arts was established in 1969. This was followed by the Faculty of Economics (1970); the Faculty of Mathematical, Physical and Natural Sciences, and the Faculty of Law (1972); the Full Degree in Engineering (1983); the Faculty of Pharmacy (1991); the Faculty of Political Science (1992); the Faculty of Foreign Languages and Literature (1996); finally, the Faculty of Medicine and Surgery (2006). As of 1987, the University is located in the town of Fisciano, a few kilometers from Salerno, at the junction of motorway intersections that make it central and easy to reach. The university is a very large compound in continuous expansion, covering around 100,000 square metres. Organized in the form of a campus (comprising the campuses of Fisciano and Baronissi), the university is equipped with residence halls for students and teachers, and boasts modern facilities and efficient services for orientation, teaching, studying and leisure activities. It currently counts about 40,000 students from Campania, Basilicata, Calabria and Apulia.



University of Primorska

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The University of Primorska (UP) was founded in 2003 as the third university in Slovenia. The main objectives are to generate and transfer knowledge based on research and innovation and to contribute to local and European sustainable development. UP’s activities involve offering three-level curricula, including students in research projects and researchers in training, and developing strong international relationships and networks for research and training. The Faculty of Education (UP PEF), directly involved in project activities, has as its mission the training and further education of educators, teachers and other workers in kindergartens, schools and other educational institutions. 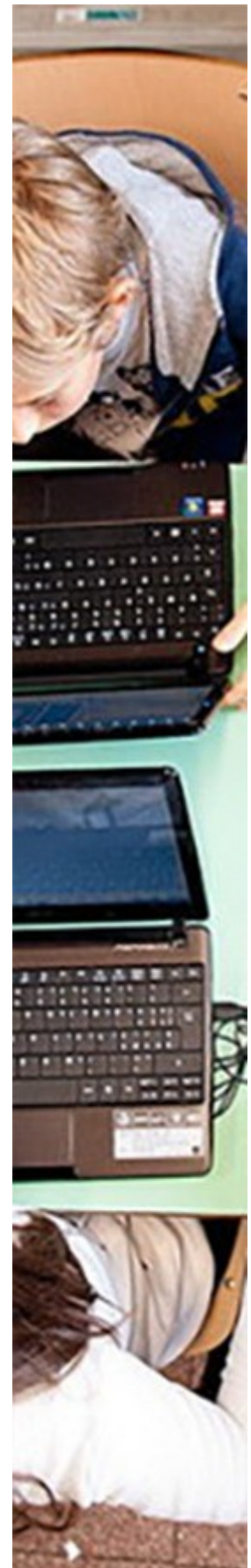


University of Peloponnese
