Who can participate?



- Students who are enrolled in the **second year** of a **Bachelor's Degree Programme** and have recorded in their online student's record at least **24 CFU** by **January 12th, 2022 at 23:59**
- Students who are enrolled in the **third (or subsequent) year** of a **Bachelor's Degree Programme** and have recorded in their online student's record at least **42 CFU** by **January 12th, 2022 at 23:59**
- Students who are enrolled in a **Master's Degree Programme**
- Students who are enrolled in a **PhD Programme**



ATTENTION



In case of transfer from another University, internal course transfer or option, only the credits earned for the study programme in which the student is currently enrolled shall be valid.

Credits earned from the following shall not be considered valid for the selection process:

- ✎ exams/internships acknowledged in previous academic careers concluded with the award of the qualification or following withdrawal/forfeiture or other activities, even held before enrolment, for which an exemption has been granted in the career
- ✎ exams taken as single courses prior to enrolment in the Bachelor's degree and/or Master's degree programmes

When can I carry out the Exchange Programme?



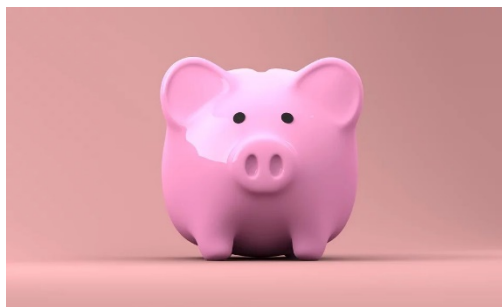
Mobilities can be carried out either in the **first or in the second semester of the a.y 2022/2023**

Check the file Attachment A – Destinations of the Call



Departures will depend on the health measures and the indications given by the competent Italian authorities, Countries of destination, Host universities and Ca' Foscari University in relation to the emergency linked to the spread of Covid-19. Depending on host universities policies, courses could be provided online

Financial Contribution



- ➡ Students who take part in the Overseas mobility will receive a **contribution** to cover their expenses
- ➡ For **each destination** there is a **specific contribution**
- ➡ A **further contribution** will be granted to students who will receive the recognition of at least **12 ECTS credits**.
- ➡ The contribution will be issued on the **University account card** (CartaConto)

How do I choose the destination?



- 👉 Check **Attachment A – Destinations**
- 👉 Download the **Factsheet** of the Partner Universities: you may find them in Attachment A – Destinations
- 👉 Visit the **pages dedicated to the Exchange Students** in the websites of the Partner Universities
- 👉 Read the **Overseas Final Reports** in your Personal Area: you will find feedback from students who already carried out their mobility

Some suggestions:



- ➡ Check if your degree programme and your plan of study are **compatible** with the courses offered by the Partner University: choose the Host University according to its **academic offer**, do not choose considering the country of the Host University only!
- ➡ **Look for the courses** offered by the Host University **by yourself**: there is no Academic Coordinator for each destination
- ➡ Carefully check the **language requirements** of the Partner University
- ➡ Consider the **financial costs** of the mobility and collect information on the country where the Partner University is
- ➡ Save the **free credits** in your plan of study and use them during the mobility. You will have more flexibility when choosing the courses to take abroad. You will also be able to obtain the recognition of exams which are not offered by Ca' Foscari

How do I apply?

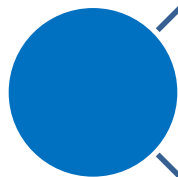


- ➡ After carefully reading the Call for Application, **access your Personal Area > Bandi di mobilità > 1° Bando Overseas a.a. 2022/2023**
- ➡ You must then:
 1. fill in the **motivation letter**;
 2. **choose the destinations** (you can select up to 3 destinations in order of preference)

!!! The motivation letter can be filled in only once, and it cannot be modified if you confirm it !!!

The application is considered valid only if you complete the motivation letter and choose the destinations.

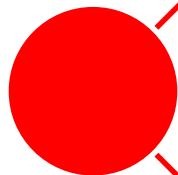

Students who did not carry out an Overseas Exchange Programme in presence in the a.y. 2020/21 are entitled to **1 bonus point on the final score.**

* Only exams regularly registered by 23:59 on 12th January 2022 will be taken into account. In case of transfer from another University, internal course transfer or option, only the credits earned for the study programme in which the student is currently enrolled shall be valid. Except as provided in the previous paragraph, credits earned from the following shall not be considered valid for the selection process: a) exams/internships acknowledged in previous academic careers concluded with the award of the qualification or following withdrawal/forfeiture or other activities, even held before enrolment, for which an exemption has been granted in the career; b) exams taken as single courses prior to enrolment in the Bachelor's degree and/or Master's degree programmes.



Rankings and how to accept the place

Rankings will be published in the Personal Area at www.unive.it on **January 31st 2022**

Students who are selected:

1 destination

Students in the reserve list:

+ destinations

Accepting the place (only for students who are selected)

Formal acceptance of the place must be made by the students who are selected **by 12:00pm (noon), February 3rd 2022** by filling out the **appropriate online form**.

Important!



- ✎ If you **withdraw** after accepting the place, you cannot participate in the Calls for application a.y. 2023/2024, and in the second Call for Application a.y. 2022/2023, except when the withdrawal is due to documented evidence of force majeure
- ✎ During the mobility period you are not allowed to take exams at Ca' Foscari. The mobility period cannot be changed. You must be regularly enrolled at Ca' Foscari University for the whole mobility period. It is forbidden to graduate before the end of the mobility period
- ✎ In order to obtain both the contribution and the credit recognition, you must **complete all the requirements** listed in the Call for Application
- ✎ After accepting the place, you will be required to **prepare the application** for the Host University, following the instructions you will receive from the Mobility Unity
- ✎ **Final acceptance always depends on the Host University**



Frequently Asked Questions

Q: If I win a place for a destination and at the same time I am on the reserve list for other destinations, may I wait for one of the places in the reserve list or by doing so I lose my place as winner in the first place?

A: You can win only once. If you do not accept the place you have been allocated, you lose the right to carry out the mobility. Please choose the destinations carefully! If instead you are in the reserve list, you can be selected for all the destinations.

Q: In the academic offer of the Host University there are no courses available for me according to my plan of study. What shall I do?

A: You shall choose another destination. The one you chose is not suitable for you.



Frequently Asked Questions

Q. In the Attachment A – Destinations, the University I am interested in requires IELTS 6.0. If I hold a Cambridge FCE certification, would it be considered valid by the Host University?

A: Language requirements set by the Host Universities are very different:

- If the language requirement is **recommended** it means that the Host University will also accept other certifications than the ones stated in the Attachment A.
- If the language requirement is **compulsory** it means that you must hold a language certificate. If the language certificate is stated in the attachment (*i.e.* IELTS 6.5 / TOEFL iBT 86) it means that you must possess a specific certificate with a specific level/score exclusively. If you do not possess one of the language certificates required with a specific level/score, the Host University will reject your application.

Check the language requirements for each University you are interested in by visiting the webpage dedicated to Incoming Exchange Students of the Host University.



Frequently Asked Question

Q: Can I participate in the Call for Application if I do not possess the language certificates required by the Host University by the deadline of the Call?

A: Yes, you can. When applying for the Overseas Call you are only required to self-certificate your level of language proficiency. You must then submit the language certificate required by the Host University within the deadline for the application to the Host University (You may check the deadlines in the Attachment A – Destinations > Deadline for Application Fall/Spring semester).

ATTENTION! If you do not hold the language certificate required by the Host University by the deadline to submit the application, the Host University may reject your application and you will not be able to carry out the mobility period.

Q: Can I participate both in the Overseas Call for Application and in the Erasmus+ Study Programme Call for Application in the same academic year?

A: Yes, you can, provided that you possess the requisites for both Calls. You can carry out two mobilities with two different programmes in the same academic year. It will be your responsibility to check that the mobility periods do not overlap.
