## Grading System

Full study load for one semester	Usually 30 ECTS (corresponding to 30 CFU)
Grading system	The Italian grading system works on a scale from 18 to 30. 18 is the lowest passing grade (sufficiency). 30L is the highest grade (30 cum laude). Only if you pass the exam of a course will you obtain the relevant credits. Exams usually give 6 or 12 credits. Only the exams that are specified in the Learning Agreement will be then be reported on the Transcript of Records.
