

Graduation at the partner University makes students eligible for an OPT extended stay, a visa which gives the right to work in the United States for the following 3 years.

Students who are selected for the double degree programme may not carry out or have carried out any other type of mobility (e.g. Erasmus+ for study or placement, Overseas, SEMP, etc.) during the same cycle of studies, under penalty of exclusion from selection or cancellation of the double degree mobility.

At the date of publication of the Call for applications, the double degree agreement is being renewed. Departures will therefore be subject to completion of the procedure.
