Giulia: Potrebbe descrivere l'oggetto del suo lavoro di ricerca?

Luis Bartolo: So I work on the philosophy of logic - that's the field about reflecting what logic is, what logic does. In particular, I'm interested in the problem of non classical logics which are somehow deviate from the standard logics that we learn in first order logic courses in university, for example, even in school. The main question behind my PhD research, which I am carrying out now, is: what does it mean, for a theory of reason, the existence of non classical logic? Do they mean something? They really are relevant for that theory of reasoning, or they're just like some like fictional systems just to play with and nothing more than that?

Luis Bartolo: So I'm going to try to approach the discipline of logic from the viewpoint the framework of styles of reasoning or thinking which was developed by Ian Hacking and mainly by Alistair Crombie.
