

Application to single courses - Master in Science and Management of Climate Change

1. It is possible to apply to single courses of 6 ETC within the 20 courses offered in the Master in Science and Management of Climate Change

Places are limited to 5 participants per course.
2. For enrolment in the individual courses, the same requirements must be met as for admission to the Master.

The registration fee for each module is €500; except for the two LABS - Data, Tools and Methods for Earth Sciences which cost €250 per module. Registration for both LABS (Introduction and Practicals) is compulsory.

Deadlines

September 8th 2023 for the 1st term
January 8th 2024 for the 2nd term

4. Attendance is compulsory. Only those who have attained at least 80% attendance of the training activities specific to each individual module will be admitted to the relative final examination, unless otherwise specified.
5. Those who will successfully pass the final exam will be issued with a certificate stating the number of credits acquired and the relevant SSD.
6. The enrollment procedure will remain open until places are filled.
7. Should the candidate enrolled in individual modules decide to complete the training course and obtain the degree in subsequent editions of the Master's degree, the Course Teaching Board will assess, on a case-by-case basis, the possible exemption from attending modules already successfully completed and the reduction of the enrolment fee in accordance with the University Regulations, which provide for a maximum reduction of 20% of the enrolment fee (<https://www.unive.it/pag/8260/>).
