Abstract	<p>Enhancing of social and environmental conditions for a group of Island belonging to the Bissagos Islands. In particular, this project aims at implementing the activities developed over the first year of the Regional project and is complementary to the EU DCI NSA PVD 2012/290-488 "BUBAQUE CIDADE ABERTA" project with regards to the goals of managing and giving value to the territory from a cultural and environmental point of view. Furthermore, the project's goal is to replicate the good practices started for the waste management on the Island of Bubaque and the nearest ones (Canhabaque, Soga, Rubane and Orango). In fact, over the first year of the project, on these island there has been a strong interest by the local population about protection, environmental enhancement and cultural development, as well as the necessities to be provided with adequate tools to manage their own waste, following the Bubaque example.</p> <p>The first year of the project has been giving Bubaque's population the opportunity to become aware of the risks related to a missing waste management. Therefore, this project aims at implementing the training of young people about the good practices started for the waste management so as to make the Island of Bubaque an example for the whole archipelago.</p> <p>Within the frame of territory enhancement, a training course in ""eco-guide"" will be made for some young people from the</p>
