Abstract	<p>This project deals with health conditions and individual economic choices, with a particular focus on the ending phase of the life cycle, in which on the one hand there is a transition from active to non-active working life, on the other hand there is a request for long-term care (LTC) for non self-sufficient elderly people.</p> <p>The focus will be on the empirical study of “potential demand” for LTC based on objective health indicators (activities of daily living - ADL) detected on the individual level, trying to establish how much of this demand is met by public services and how much by family members, considering as well the possible complementarity among these different forms of assistance.</p>
